Job Description:

Responsible for the planning, coordinating & instructing of after school programs at various schools and community centers throughout the assigned service areas*. Where appropriate, give guidance to the cultivating, recruiting and training for volunteers in the assigned service area*. Serves as a representative of the Narragansett Council with community organizations in assigned service area*.

Job Qualification:

The youth program leader must have a willingness to work hard and work effectively with youth and adults. Must be familiar with communities of the assigned service area* and be willing to participate in assigned training courses. Must demonstrate effective communication skills to convey information to youth and their families – Spanish Speaking is a plus. Must have the ability to work evenings and weekends and understand that occasionally there will be unavoidable schedule changes.

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide leadership to Scoutreach units assigned.
- Follow the prescribed lesson plans, as outlined
- Complete training necessary for your areas of responsibility
- Ensure that the rewards program is correctly administrated
- Conduct field trips, campouts, cultural activities, and other horizon-broadening experiences for the youth members
- Strive to ensure that every youth participant will have the opportunity to earn a minimum of one rank advancement during the program year.
- Assist in the recruiting of youth and adult members to Scouting.
- Provide supervision and training to all volunteers and possible program aides assigned.
- Ensure that all Scouts are provided the opportunity for short term camp, summer resident camp opportunities and an outdoor program.
- Organize new Scoutreach units in target communities.
- Keep attendance logs and meeting plans from weekly Scout meetings.

Assume such additional responsibilities as may be assigned by you supervisor.
